While taking a test for a major automotive company, I decided to take a look under the hood to see how my grading was being performed. I didn't use any tools like burp suite, I just used the Developer Tools and took a look at the javascript that was loading dynamically and I noticed something interesting.

When you hover over a blank space on the bottom, there was obviously an object. While not yet visible, this tells me that at some point, this space loads or will show something later:

Blank Space

So I decide to check in the developer source code section to see what this space does, and I happened to notice a hidden form field. Usually when I encounter hidden fields, I try to delete them and see what appears on screen and attempt to interact with it:

As it turns out, this blank space later occupies the area that tells you whether or not you got the question right or wrong and also displays what the correct answer was:
